



Exclusion Periods

Medication / Ailment		Exclusion Period
Chicken Pox		5 days from diagnosis or until spots have dried, whichever is longer
Conjunctivitis		Until eye discharge stops or treatment begins
Covid-19	Levels 1 & 2	No exclusion period unless combined with another condition requiring exclusion
	Level 3	3 days from diagnosis
Diarrhoea		48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea
Hand, Foot & Mouth		No exclusion period unless combined with another condition requiring exclusion
Headlice		Until treatment has started
Medication		24 hours after the first dose of a new medication
Paracetamol (e.g., Calpol)		For the remainder of the day in which the paracetamol was administered
Temperature more than or equal to 38°		For the remainder of the day in which the high temperature occurred
Vaccinations		No exclusion period unless combined with another condition requiring exclusion
Vomiting		48 hours after the last episode of vomiting
Other		Please enquire for guidance

HOW IT WORKS

Our exclusion periods are generally based on governmental guidelines, available on the www.gov.uk website. However, we may enforce stricter exclusion periods if we determine there is a significant risk to the health and well-being of other children, staff, or families.
